	Snowy Houses	-Students will learn about how shapes (element of art) can create recognizable objects. -Students will learn to stamp using different materials.	Students will create a house collage using simple shapes. They will use pencil erasers to stamp on the snow.	1 class
	Shape Robots	-Students will learn about how shapes (element of art) can create recognizable objects.	Students will create simple shape robots. They will use different materials to create collage elements to their robots.	1 class
	Collage Cornucopia	-Students will learn about different techniques for creating texture (element of art) in collage.	Students will learn about what a cornucopia (horn of plenty) is. They will tear paper to create a texture on their basket. They will then draw different fruits and	2 classes

	Collage Owls	-Students will use texture and shape (elements of art) to create collage owls.	vegetables to fill their cornucopia. Students will create a brown barn owl collage. They will draw the basic parts of the owl, and tear paper to fill it, using different brown tones to highlight the texture. They will then use collage paper to add details.	2 classes
Painting	Snowy Owls	-Students will learn to use shape and line (elements of art) to create a recognizable animal.	Students will create a painting of a snowy owl using simple shapes and lines. They will add details and snow.	1 class
	Jasper Johns Letter Paintings	-Students will learn about the life and artwork of artist Jasper Johns.	Students will create a painting of letters based on Jasper Johns' painting "Colored Alphabet". They will paint the letter using tempera paint, and then fill in the negative spaces around the letters with watercolors.	2 classes
	Winter Trees	-Students will learn to create the color (element of art) green, along with variations of it.	Students will trace different triangles on their paper to create trees. They will add in a ground line, and paint the sky	2 classes

Painting (cont.)	Space Paintings	-Students will learn about how to create different colors using only primary colors (element of art).	<p>blue. They will then mix different shades of green using different amounts of blue, yellow and white, to paint their trees. They will stamp snow with the end of their paintbrushes.</p> <p>Students will create paintings of outer space by mixing red, yellow and blue together to create new colors. They will paint planets, comets and shooting stars and then stamp stars with the end of their paint brush. They will draw rocket ships and add them to their paintings.</p>	2 classes
Drawing	Name Crown	-Students will learn cutting techniques and practice drawing patterns.	Students will create a crown with their name on it. They will practice cutting along the lines at the top edge to create the points. They will draw patterns on the crown using familiar lines and shapes.	1 class

Drawing (cont.)	Line Design	-Students will discover how lines (element of art) make different patterns.	Students will create a line design filling in their entire paper, making sure the lines go from one edge to the other. They will color each section a different color, again making sure to fill the page.	2 classes
	Cookie Monster Drawing	-Students will learn how simple lines and shapes (elements of art) can be used to make a familiar character.	Students will follow along with the teacher without knowing what the end result will be. They will draw shapes and lines, creating Cookie Monster. Once the character is discovered and completed, students will add a background and color.	1 class
	People Drawings	-Students will learn to use shapes (element of art) to create a figure.	Students will use simple shapes to draw a person. They will add all parts, making sure it is complete, before adding personal details. They will paint a paper towel, using watercolors, creating a tie dye effect. The drawn person will be cut out and glued to the paper towel.	2 classes

Clay	Pinch Pots	-Students will learn about creating forms (element of art) out of clay.	Students will create different forms (sphere, cylinder, cone, cube). They will return their clay to a sphere and create a pinch pot. Their pinch will be painted.	2 classes
Wax/Pastel Resist	Watercolor Castles	-Students will learn to use shapes to create a castle.	Students will create a castle drawing using simple shapes. They will fill it in with details using oil pastel. These will be painted with water color, creating a pastel resist.	1 class
	Twittering Machine	-Students will learn about the life and artwork of artist Paul Klee. -Students will learn to use line (element of art) to show sound.	Students will look at and discuss Paul Klee's "The Twittering Machine". They will brainstorm what type of music it is playing. Students will create a drawing of their own music making machine, adding lines to show the noise that's being made. These will be painted with watercolors.	1 class
